Also a blackboard for doodling/drinks specials would be cool.
- **Bar events:** as well as hopefully bringing back gin and jazz, I'd try to arrange a 'pub quiz'/curry and quiz in the bar if there was enough interest. I'm open to event suggestions because I want to do events other people actually want to do, I'm not going to force karaoke on you all unless you actually want it.
