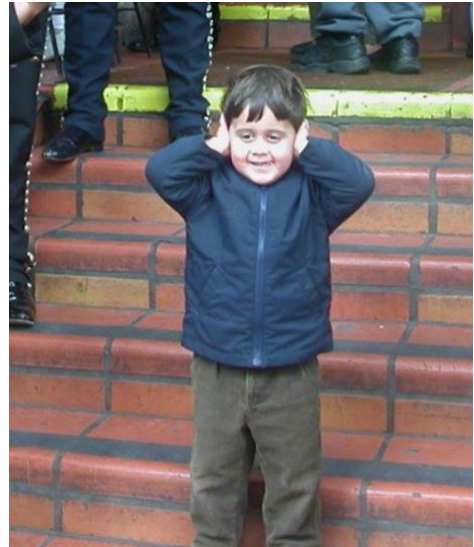


SHAYAN FOR BME OFFICER
