1. Affiliation

- The splitting up of the Film Society was discussed
- Tom Bendall noted that it would be good if the budget could be put online with the minutes, which was given as a job to the Secretary.
- The budget list of affiliated societies is exhaustive, as affiliation needs to be redone every year, however other clubs have been affiliated in the past that are not now.

2. Budget

- PLoDRs asked why they did not get all their funding: unfortunately Amals does not subsidise trips, College has funds for that.
- Film A and Film B society (and BFS) should check whether they need a film license.
- Mixed Lacrosse was given £5 for league/cuppers fees.
- Similarly, Tennis was given £30.
- Rose was wondering how you get the money: give it to James Brind (receipt/form) and then he will give to Jeremy Boyd, then there will be a cheque written.
- Duncan said that badminton was unexpectedly popular—more funds can be assigned if and when necessary.
- Men's Tennis captain (Corey) was assigned £30 for cuppers/league fees, as was Women's Tennis.
- Rachel asked, in name of CU whether they could have money for an open event: forward details.
- Henk-Jaap, as Captain of PBC mentioned that a senior budget exists, in the range of £20,000 to pay for the boatman, boat house maintenance et cetera. The committee has little control over this, and it is overseen by the Senior Treasurer/College.
- Rose Hubbard asked whether there was communal storage. There has not been since the Birdwood Building was demolished. Some items could be stored in the quiet room, however that is not ideal.
- The budget was approved.

3. Any Other Business

- There was no other business: people wanted to go to the bar.
