

Amals Committee Meeting – 15/02/14

Rugby Team

- 5 or 6 players
- Total bill £1500
- £500 short
- £250 proposed amount to go towards kit replacement

Heywood Society

- £2700 in Heywood Society account – they can't access it due to not having signatories on the account – Bendall knows one of the signatories
- Proposition to terminate the account – just pay the money to Amals, and then they just claim money from Amals?
- → Discuss with new Heywood Society President and Committee

Woman's Basketball

- C. £170 to join the league – next year
- Perfectly fine

Five-a-side Football

- Unanimous on potentially committing to funding court hire for team if sufficient interest

Election/ Co-option of captains and presidents

- Discussed more open/ democratic processes for society and sport team presidents and captains

Affiliation

- Proposal: If a society/ sport was affiliated the previous year, no need to formally affiliate the next year (unless it has demonstrably ceased to function)
- Budgets – good system at present

May Ball

- If Bursar and Dean OK with £9000 being paid back in stages, then Amals is fine with it
- Bendall will discuss with Bursar, saying May Ball Committee has requested this

Amals Function

- Bendall will go and discuss how Amals actually works, how it is funded and whether there are upper limits on funding
